Subject: Construction on Crows Landing Road Bridge Replacement Project over San Joaquin River



CROWS LANDING ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

OVER SAN JOAQUIN RIVER

In August 2021, crews began construction for the Crows Landing Road Bridge Replacement Project over the San Joaquin River, which is anticipated to be completed by October 2023.

Work activities will take place on **Crows Landing Road** between **River Road/Marshal Road and S. Carpenter Road on Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.** The County recommends that motorists use alternative routes whenever possible during construction to avoid delays.

Upcoming Road Work Activities

February 2022

Between Carpenter Road and Crows Landing Bridge crews will be installing K-Rail (modular concrete barrier) to provide a protective barrier to separate traffic from the adjacent work area. During construction, travelers should expect:

- A temporary realignment of Southbound traffic to install K-Rail
- Temporary lane closure
- Reduced 11-foot lane width in both directions

April 2022

A closure will occur at the intersection of Carpenter Road and Crows Landing Road for up to 60-days due to construction. During this closure, travelers should:

- Utilize the suggested detour at Ruble Road to access Carpenter Road
- Drive safely while following construction signs and the instructions of on-site personnel

June 2022

Traffic will be redirected on to the newly constructed portion of Crows Landing Bridge.

Project Staging

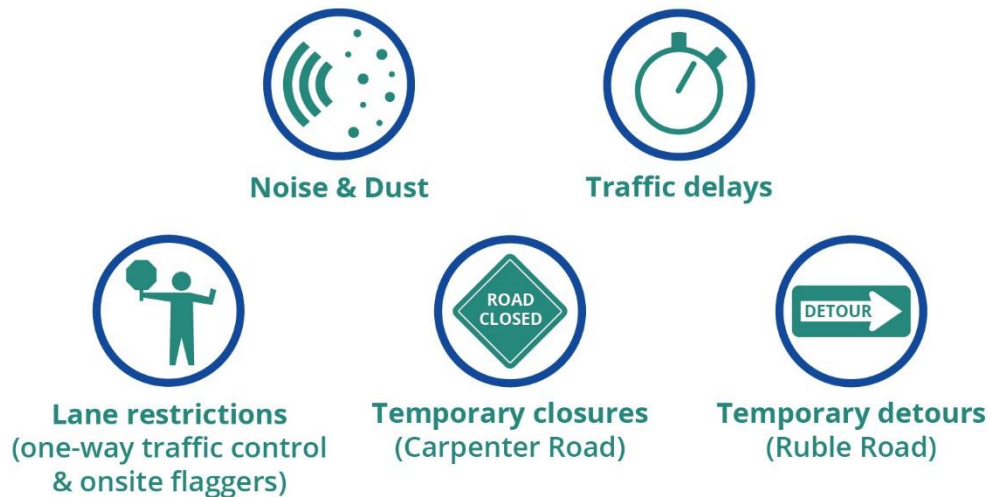
To minimize impacts and maintain traffic movement for travelers, construction will be conducted in two stages:

- **Stage 1 (Summer 2021-Summer 2022):** Installation of temporary trestle over San Joaquin River and then construction of the south side of the new bridge.
- **Stage 2 (Beginning Summer 2022):** Construction of the north side of the new bridge, removal of temporary trestle over San Joaquin River, and then roadway improvement work before bridge opens.

Once complete, the new bridge will widen both travel lanes and road shoulders to improve safety for motorists as well as meet Caltrans and American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials structural and geometric standards.

Potential Impacts

During construction, access to local property owners will be maintained and potential road closure near properties will be coordinated on an individual basis. In addition, public safety access will be maintained at all times throughout construction. Local property owners and the traveling public may experience:
