Subject: Construction Update: Crows Landing Road Bridge Replacement Project

Work on the Crows Landing Road Bridge Replacement Project is currently in Stage 2, the final construction stage. Due to recent flooding, work is paused and storm recovery is estimated to begin in June with Stage 2 work resuming in July.

Remaining Stage 2 work includes constructing the new bridge approaches and the new roadway. By the end of 2023, construction will be complete with full-width traffic lanes.

Project Overview

- **Work hours:** Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (use alternative routes whenever possible)
- **Construction location:** Crows Landing Road between River Road/Marshal Road and South Carpenter Road
- **Projected completion:** December 2023
- **Project benefits:**
 - Improving safety for motorists
 - Ensuring the bridge meets structural and geometric standards
 - Widening the travel lanes and road shoulders
