## **CROWS LANDING ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

Work on the Crows Landing Road Bridge Replacement Project is currently in Stage 2, the final construction stage. Construction had paused due to flooding and resumed on July 31.

Stage 2 work includes constructing the east side of the new bridge and a new roadway. By the end of 2023, construction will be complete with full-width traffic lanes.

### **Project Overview**

- **Work hours:** Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (use alternative routes whenever possible)
- **Construction location:** Crows Landing Road between River Road/Marshal Road and South Carpenter Road
- **Projected completion:** December 2023
- **Project benefits:**
  - Improving safety for motorists
  - Ensuring the bridge meets structural and geometric standards
  - Widening the travel lanes and road shoulders
