Subject: Construction Update: Crows Landing Road Bridge Replacement Project

Work on the Crows Landing Road Bridge Replacement Project is currently in Stage 2, the final construction stage. Starting Sunday, October 1 – Saturday October 7, there will be a lane closure. A reversible traffic lane will be established to keep traffic moving during this time.

Flood impacts on the construction site have been cleaned up and the new bridge foundation supporting substructure is complete. Currently, the team is constructing the bridge falsework (temporary structures built to support the construction of the new permanent structure) on the roadway. Roadway work is also starting by the bridge approaches. By early 2024, Crows Landing Road Bridge will open with full-width traffic lanes.

Work hours: Monday - Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (use alternative routes whenever possible)

Construction location: Crows Landing Road between River Road/Marshal Road and South Carpenter Road

Projected completion: January 2024

- Constructing the bridge approach and roadway
