Work on the Crows Landing Road Bridge Replacement Project is nearing completion! Single lane road closures will be made throughout the week of April 1 and as needed.

The Team is currently preparing to pave and paint the road, and prepping the last barrier pour. Teams are planning to remove the falsework and trestle (bridge support) within the coming months, along with finalizing bridge work such as railings, guardrails, and signage.

Project Overview

Work hours: Monday - Friday 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (use alternative routes whenever possible)

Construction location: Crows Landing Road between River Road/Marshal Road and South Carpenter Road

Projected completion: Late Spring 2024

Project benefits:

- Improving safety for motorists
- Ensuring the bridge meets structural and geometric standards
- Widening the travel lanes and road shoulder

- Constructing the deck barrier and positioning the deck closure pour
- Constructing the bridge approach, drainage, and roadway
- Removing the falsework and trestle
