Work on the Crows Landing Road Bridge Replacement Project is nearing completion! Single lane road closures will be made as needed.

The Team removed the falsework and trestle (bridge support) and finished grinding the roadway for the bridge. Teams are planning to implement rock slope protection, which helps prevent erosion, along with installing other safety measures—such as signage and guard rails.

Project Overview

Work hours: Monday - Friday 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (use alternative routes whenever possible)

Construction location: Crows Landing Road between River Road/Marshal Road and South Carpenter Road

Projected completion: June 2024

- Widening the travel lanes and road shoulder
